

A.C.T. TEST PREPARATION WORKSHOPS

2014-2015

Description: All workshops are open to all public, parochial, private and homeschooled students, grades 9-12. These widely acclaimed five-hour workshops help students prepare for the ACT test. Students will:

- Learn specifically how ACT and SAT scores and GPA impact college admission and scholarships.
- Learn ACT test-taking and essay strategies, and build ACT pacing skill, familiarity and confidence.
- Take an official, full-length (3½ hours), strictly timed ACT practice test and essay.
- Receive their practice test scores at the workshop. **Parents** are emailed test and essay scores and tips.
- Learn an established self-help method for correcting and understanding mistakes made on the practice test. It is designed to help students significantly improve their scores (**often 3-8 points**) on any follow-up practice or live ACT. By design, all ACT tests have similar timing, format, material and difficulty.

Students must bring a watch, two #2 pencils and a non-texting calculator, and may bring a light snack and bottled water.
