POWERS CATHOLIC SERVICE REQUIREMENT

A school-wide service program has been instituted at Powers Catholic in order to develop in students a sense of responsibility as Christians and as citizens to give back to the communities which have nurtured and fostered them. As a Catholic Christian community, we have the further obligation of fulfilling scriptural demands and the example of Christ Himself to love and serve others, especially "the least ones."

Each student is required to perform five (5) hours of service for each semester of attendance. This service is to be done outside of school hours (excluding Study Hall hours), on an unpaid, volunteer basis, as an independent assignment which cannot be "counted" for other school requirements. A broad range of activities will be permitted. For underclassmen (Freshmen & Sophomores), who are not as mobile as old upperclassmen (Juniors & Seniors), service at home or in their neighborhoods will be acceptable. Upperclassmen need to complete their service hours through a community organization or group, church or school facility.

The completion of five hours of service for each semester of attendance is a graduation requirement. Progress towards completion of this requirement will be monitored as follows:

1. Each semester students will turn in a signed service form indicating completion of their volunteer service and signed by the supervisor of the activity to the Christian Service Coordinator.
2. Semester reports are available showing the type and number of service hours verified for each student.
3. If a student fails to complete the required service hours, they will not receive a diploma from Powers Catholic High School.

Powers Catholic High School students are already involved in providing service in many different ways. This program, for them, will be simply an acknowledgment that what they are doing is important and praiseworthy.

Students who complete 20 service hours by the end of third quarter each year will receive a Student Service Award at the Honors Assembly.
